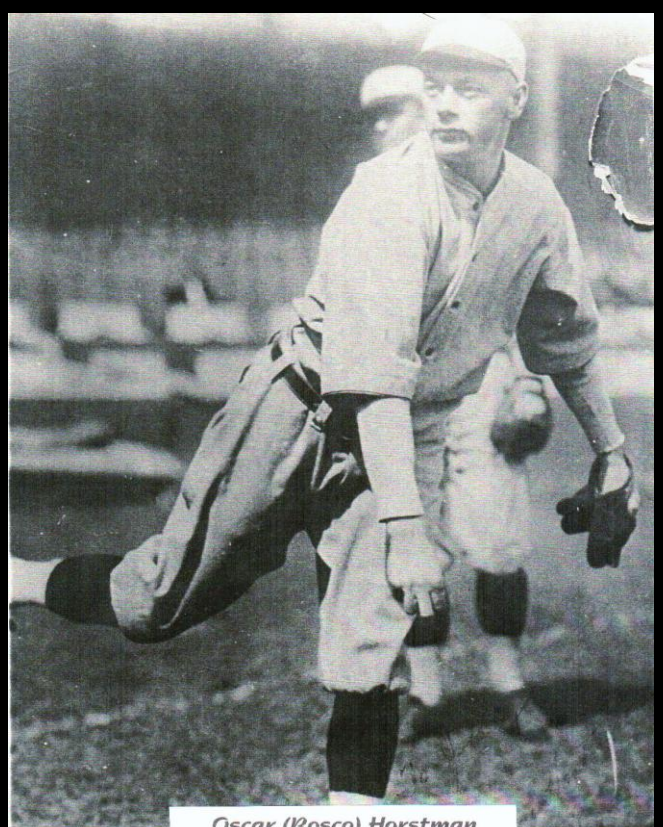
Oscar "Bosco" Horstman

Born June 2, 1891 in Alma, MO

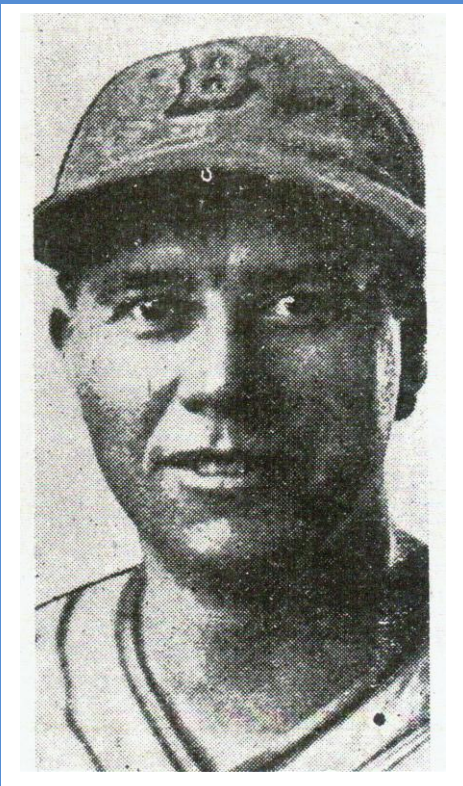
Died May 11, 1977 in Salina, KS



Oscar "Bosco" Horstman, was a pitcher with the Cardinals from 1917-1919. He made his debut on April 18, 1917. He was honored into the National Baseball Hall of Fame.

Born March 15, 1907 in Alma, MO

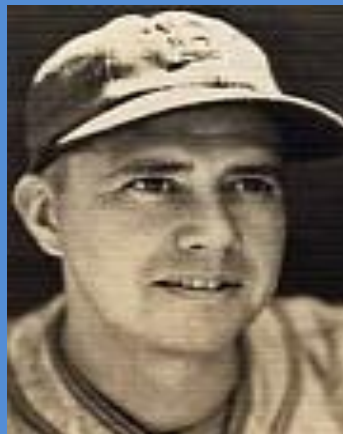
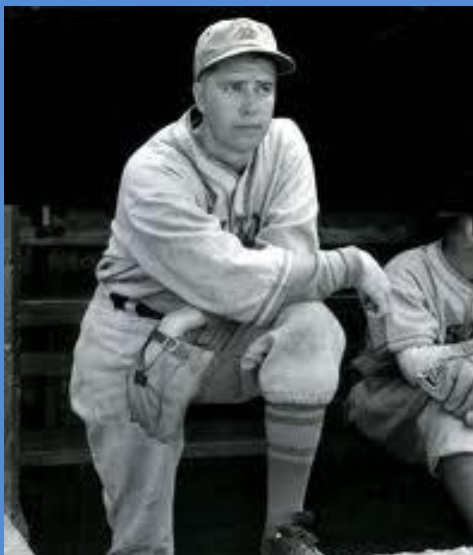
Died January 3, 1981 in Warrensburg, MO



Fette attended school at MO Valley College in Marshall, MO. He was debuted April 26, 1937. He played for the Boston Bees (#16) from 1937-1939; in 1940 he switched to #18. In 1940 he was #21 for the Brooklyn Dodgers and in 1945 he was #23 with the Boston Braves. Fette's final game was June 22, 1945 with the Braves. Fette also pitched in the All-Star Game in 1939.



He was a Pitcher for the Kansas City Blues.

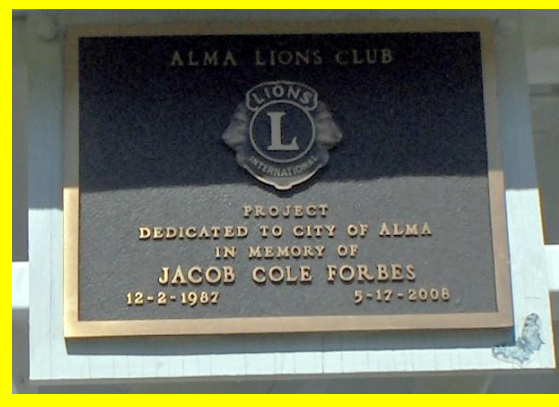
