Reminder that the City of Alma has a regulation on open burning of residential yard waste.

With the Fall season upon us, many will begin the dreaded task of raking the leaves. Last year the Council passed an Ordinance regarding open burning after several reports of out of control burning in a residential area. Alma residents are still allowed to burn yard waste and leaves, but just in a controlled setting and with a little common sense.

Here are a few restrictions outlined in the Ordinance:

1. All fires must be at least 20ft. away from any building or structure.
2. All fires shall be monitored from a point on the property where the fire is located by a person capable of containing a fire; a child 12 and under is not considered a person capable of containing a fire.
3. If the safety of the community or the public may be endangered, the Mayor, Fire Department or Police Department may invoke a temporary burning ban.
4. All fires must be completely extinguished by 8:00 P.M.
5. The burning of garbage, tires, fabric, furniture and other kinds of waste is Prohibited!
